United Way of Johnson County’s Economic Assistance Plan – Navigating Job Loss

United Way of Johnson County created a program to help families struggling with job loss in these tough economic times. In 2009, United Way received funding to establish the United Way of Johnson County’s Economic Assistance Plan, which allowed our agency to partner with several local organizations to provide services for families who have recently lost their jobs or have had a significant loss of income due to the economy.

This plan is assisting families find resources and financial assistance throughout Johnson County to help them through their struggling time. It also provides educational opportunities for families to learn effective ways to better manage financial resources.

From its beginning in August of 2009 through Dec. 31, 2010, 387 individuals from 113 families had received services from the Economic Assistance Plan. In total, these families received \$283,782 in financial assistance during their time with the program. Financial assistance given included help with rent and mortgages as well as utilities assistance. Families in need of assistance should contact United Way of Johnson County for more information.

Moving into 2011, the Economic Assistance Plan will begin shifting its focus to being a full-time case management system for residents of Johnson County.

Disaster Relief

Johnson County Community Organizations Active in Disasters (JCCOAD)

JCCOAD assisted families with immediate needs, construction and case management to help them get back their lives as they were before the June 2008 disasters struck Johnson County. JCCOAD completed their recovery efforts on Dec. 31, 2010. In total, JCCOAD provided case management to 915 families and construction assistance was given to 172 homes to help rebuild. Families affected by the flood were also able to receive reimbursement if they paid to repair their own homes before JCCOAD was able to assist them. Sixty-five households received reimbursement dollars.

JCCOAD’s board of directors will now focus on developing disaster response plans in order to help there be strategies in place in case of future disasters.
