Here are some opportunities for you:

Campaign volunteer positions: As we move forward through these tough economic times, it is essential that we have the volunteers needed to help raise the necessary dollars to support our United Way of Johnson County agencies. The following are areas for the campaign that we **REALLY** need your assistance. Please consider helping out.

2011 Campaign Cabinet: Help plan and implement the overall fundraising effort for the fall fundraising campaign. Time commitment is approximately two meetings per month beginning in March with additional volunteer time in-between meetings.

2011 Account Executives: Call on the management of local companies/organizations to obtain the commitment for a United Way employee campaign, corporate gift and leadership gift from management.

2011 Loaned Executive: Loaned Executives are volunteers who do United Way presentations during employee campaigns. Time commitment is equivalent to 1/2 day per week during June through December.

2011 Telethons: Twice a year, we have a telethon to solicit funds from community businesses and leadership giving. Phone shifts are in 2-hour increments.

2011 Restaurant Campaign: In 2010, we piloted the United We Dine restaurant campaign. We need volunteers to help make calls on local restaurants encouraging them to participate in the campaign and then help to market the campaign to the general public.

2012-2013 Allocations Committees: Recommend a specific dollar amount to be allocated to the assigned agency and general recommendations about the agency. Specific duties include: attend a two-hour allocations training session; review all materials; visit assigned agencies during designated time period; participate in the half-day allocations deliberation to review specific agencies' requests.

2011 Christmas Angels Volunteers: Volunteers help to plan and implement this program that provides toys and clothing to children in need during the Christmas season. We particularly need individuals who would commit to helping in the office four hours per week during the months of November and December. Volunteers are also needed during the client application process.

2011 Communications Committee: Help plan and implement the annual celebration and kick-off events, as well as other marketing tools.

2011 Day of Caring Project Managers: Organize the largest volunteer project in Johnson County by helping to match and coordinate employees to volunteer on Day of Caring at United Way agencies. Volunteers act as project managers for agencies and companies. Time commitment is one meeting per month beginning in April through September. Additional volunteer time is needed between meetings.

2011 Fast Track Volunteers: Volunteers are needed to serve on the committee or subcommittees. Committee responsibilities include speaker's bureau, fundraising, "Stuff the Bus" event and recruiting vendors for the Fast Track events. Volunteers are also needed the days of the five, Fast Track events.

2011 Golf Committee: Help us to plan and carry out our annual Golf Outing. Committee members solicit sponsorships and door prizes, plan and carry out our Golf Outing. Time commitment is one meeting per month beginning in January through August, with additional time between meetings.

Helpline Volunteers: Assist with answering Helpline calls to offer information and referral to organizations providing various social services. Additional volunteer opportunities include administrative duties.

Operation Bundle Up Committee: Coats will be collected during September/October and distributed to children in November. We need volunteers to help with school contacts, local businesses and organizations as well as sorting of donated coats and then to help implement the distribution event. Time commitment is one meeting per month beginning in June through November. Additional volunteer time is needed between meetings.

Office Volunteers: Office volunteers are needed to come in on consistent basis to help with mailings, filing, and assembling of information packets.
