









## CHRISTMAS ANGELS GIFT SPONSOR INFORMATION



### PLEASE READ CAREFULLY

-  The Christmas Angels Program is designed to provide gifts for children (newborn to 17) of Johnson County residents who would otherwise not have a Christmas. Families must qualify to be eligible for the program.
-  There are two ways families can receive assistance through the Christmas Angels Program. After families complete an application, they are either matched to a sponsor or will be invited to shop at the Angel Tree Store.
-  Christmas Angels is not intended to supplement other Christmas assistance that families may receive through family members, organizations such as The Salvation Army, or a local church that has their own program. United Way of Johnson County works with other Christmas assistance programs in the county to screen for duplication.
-  As a Gift Sponsor, you are committing to collecting new toys/gifts/clothing to help stock the Angel Tree Store.
-  Gift items for tweens and teens are always needed for the Angel Tree Store. Please see the attached list of suggestions for gift items.
-  Drop off gifts will be December 8, 2025, from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. at Grace United Methodist Church, 1300 East Adams Street Franklin, IND. Please enter through door C2. Please call United Way of Johnson County if you need your gifts picked up.
