## YOUTH SERVICES

**3,542**

youth received assistance from United Way of Johnson County's direct programs: Christmas Angels, Fast Track and Operation Bundle Up. Total value of services provided was **\$202,750**.

**170**

youth and their families received **\$75,000** in counseling services as they were facing the challenges of being physically, sexually or mentally abused; addressing drug and alcohol addiction; or dealing with bullying.

**1,702**

youth gained the confidence and life skills necessary to become leaders of tomorrow through scouting programs.

**1,221**

youth had a safe and affordable place to go before/ after school, summer-day camps or preschool programs.



## SENIOR SERVICES

**755**

older adults had the chance to participate in wellness, exercise and social programs to keep their minds sharp and their bodies moving.

*At age 14, Danielle was able to join Venture Scouting through the Boys Scouts, Crossroads of America Council. Little did she know that all the leadership skills that she was learning like first aid and CPR would be put to use. A few years later, Danielle was coming home from work and came upon a horrific car accident. One of the passengers, a small child, wasn't breathing. And in Danielle's words, "So without even thinking, my leadership skills and CPR skills that I learned in scouting came into play. I started doing CPR on the girl. I've never been so happy to hear a scream in my life and to know that my scouting skills are what allowed me to help that little girl and her family is the most impactful thing ever."*

# FINANCIAL STABILITY SERVICES

**1,188**

individuals who were at risk of being homeless or were homeless; who needed guidance to stabilize their situation; or who had been affected by COVID-19 were provided direction and the resources needed to have stable income and housing, and given hope to their family situation. Total value of services provided was **\$86,000.**

**1,318**

individuals were served who were trying to escape domestic violence.

**9,448**

people were able to get to jobs, employment training, and medical appointments by participating in the transportation programs supported by your donations.

**3,855**

individuals received the life-line services that are vital to families who have no idea where to turn because a health diagnosis has overwhelmed their family; a disastrous event has stunned the family; or a parent is now a single-parent raising his/her children with reduced or no income.

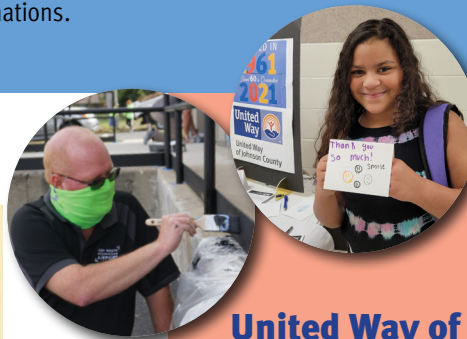
**88¢** out of every dollar collected goes back to our community
